



MolBioS Student selection criteria

Student selection will be based on analysis of the application (50%), presentation (25%) and interview (25%). The application/cv will be evaluated from 0-10 points, and the presentation and interview will be evaluated with 0-5 points, for a final mark of 0-20 points.

- **Analysis of application: 0-10 points**
 - **Weighted final grade of degrees** ($3 \times 1^{\text{st}} \text{ degree} + 2 \times \text{Masters} / 5$)†: **0-5 points**
 - **Research experience: 0-2.5 points**
(Evaluation of previous experience in research and publications)
 - **Motivation and adequacy to the program: 0-2.5 points**
(Evaluation of the motivation letter, the reference letters and the profile of the candidate in terms of adequacy to the program areas)
- **Presentation: 0-5 points**
(Evaluation of scientific content, organization and clarity, evidence of scientific proficiency and command of English)
- **Interview: 0-5 points**
(Evaluation of intellectual and scientific ability, motivation, interest/commitment to science/PhD, and command of English)

†For students with only the curricular part of the Masters course (1st year) the weighted final grade will be: $(3 \times 1^{\text{st}} \text{ degree grade} + 1 \times \text{average Masters } 1^{\text{st}} \text{ year grades}) / 4$.
